Keynote Speaker: [MaryAnn Mihychuk](#) – *MaryAnn is a professional geologist with over 30 years of expertise in the mineral sector. She is the first ever recipient of the Women in Mining Canada Trailblazer Award in 2012 and a founding director of Women in Mining Canada.*

Luncheon Speaker: [Roberta Jamieson](#) - *Roberta is the president and CEO of Indspire, a foundation dedicated to empowering communities, especially indigenous leaders and youth. She has earned numerous awards, including the National Aboriginal Achievement Award in 1998, and she has been named three times to the Women’s Executive Network’s Top 100 list.*

Interactive Breakout Workshops:

- **Mentorship and Coaching (Ben Edgson & Correne Bredin)**

A workshop sponsored by **Agrium** and **RLG** on great coaching techniques that will improve the performance, impact and results of your mentoring relationships.

- **Fierce Conversations (Rachelle Brockman)**

During this session, strategies that will allow participants to ‘come out from behind themselves into the conversation and make it real’ will be discussed. Participants will explore the art of ‘mining for truths’ and will engage in practical and interactive discussions. This activity will certainly clarify and strengthen their leadership communication abilities.

- **Leading with Courage (Sandra Ford Walston)**

During this session, participants will learn interactively how to recognize situations when courageous leadership is called for, such as giving yourself permission to be courageous, confronting uncomfortable truths, speaking without ambiguity, transcending rejection, and responding to first red flags. Participants will draw from the “Source Wheel” diagram to apply the 12 behaviours of courage. The outcome: There is a direct correlation between your success quotient and your courage quotient.
